Aged Care Development in Lewisham Approved

Catholic Healthcare is delighted to announce that its development application to renew an existing aged care home in Lewisham has been approved.

Catholic Healthcare's General Manager of Property, Michael Lockwood said, "This is an exciting time for us and will enable the development of modern, integrated person-centred aged care services for the local residents of Lewisham and its neighbouring areas."

The development will include a new seniors' living village with 117 retirement living units and 144 resident places with a range of shared facilities that will be enjoyed by residents, their families and the broader community. This will include a Chapel, café, health and wellness hub, an indoor pool and gym, hair salon, cinema, games rooms and other activity and lifestyle spaces.
